Councilman Reese files for fourth term

Vows to continue his guiding principle—“If I wouldn’t want it in my backyard, I won’t vote to put it in yours.”

LAS VEGAS – Veteran Las Vegas City Councilman and Mayor Pro Tem Gary Reese was the first candidate to file for Las Vegas City Council today, the first day of filing for the municipal elections this spring.

Reese, flanked by Mayor Oscar Goodman, Councilman Lawrence Weekly, and Councilwoman Tarkanian told a group of supporters that he was looking forward to serving the citizens of Las Vegas for another term. “There are still projects I’m working on with various neighborhoods in Ward 3, including the development of a new park, bringing new businesses into our ward and improving crime prevention and graffiti clean-up programs. I want to see the job through and make sure these projects are completed,”

Reese is known in Ward 3 for working on neighborhood issues and fighting for neighborhood improvements. “I try to make every decision affecting neighborhoods as though I lived right there,” Reese said. “I’ve been quoted

a number of times saying if I wouldn't want it in my backyard, I won't vote to put it in yours."

Noted for his dependability, Reese has never missed a vote or been late to a Las Vegas City Council meeting during his three terms of service.

Reese is married and has three children and five grandchildren. The couple has two stepchildren living them.
